



Membership Fee Structure

The Mayors' Innovation Project is a membership-based organization, and we rely on your support to keep providing a forum for mayors and staff to learn, share, network, and innovate. In 2007, the MIP Steering Committee established a membership fee.

MIP's membership fees work in the following way:

- **Fees are scaled based on a city's size** - Cities with larger budgets are asked to contribute more to the administration of the project.

City Size	MIP Membership Fee
0-50,000	\$500
50,000-150,000	\$1,000
150,000-300,000	\$1,500
300,000-500,000	\$2,000
500,000 +	\$2,500

- **Fee payment dates are flexible** - We are committed to working with cities to accommodate their budget cycles and individual situations.
- **Fees will be waived for a city's first meeting with MIP** - New members will be able to attend a meeting before committing as a full member.
- **Membership entitles each city to send one person to every MIP meeting** - If a city wishes to bring more staff, we would ask for a meeting fee that reflects the cost per person for that meeting.
- **Financial assistance will be available** - In cases in where the membership fee precludes a city's involvement in MIP, we are committed to working with cities to enable their participation.
