

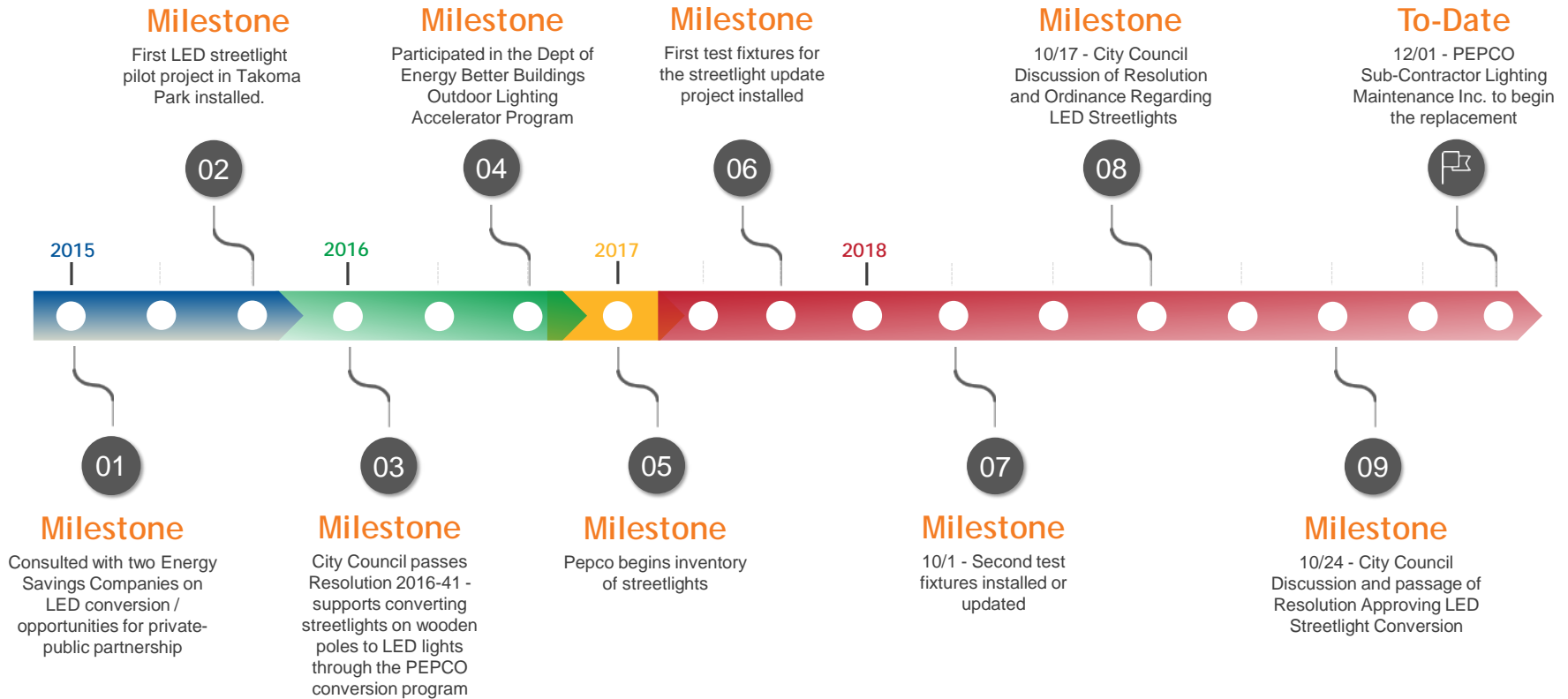

LED Streetlight Replacement:

Commitment to Sustainability and Innovation

Overview: After years of extensive research, pilot projects, and public discussions, the City Council voted unanimously to replace 1,505 streetlights

Benefits:

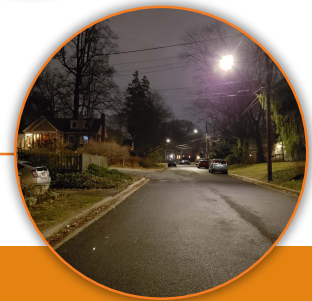
- No other Maryland jurisdiction has ever done this; **no precedent to share**
- Saves the City over **\$100,000 per year**
- New streetlights are International Dark Sky Association **(IDA) Certified**
- This is a **huge step** towards fighting climate change, reducing energy consumption, increasing public safety, and saving significant money
- Converting streetlights to LED is the **equivalent of eliminating 912,031 miles driven by a car**, each year
- Based on projected annual savings, the program **will pay for itself in <two years**
