**Green Infrastructure:** Grand Rapids is nationally recognized for their green infrastructure streetscapes. This tour will explore community-centered projects, from bioswales to porous payement, by bus with opportunities to get off and see projects up close.

**Equitable Development:** The Roosevelt Park neighborhood is one of the city's most diverse neighborhoods and, like much of the city, is experiencing growth and development. Neighborhood partners will guide us on a walk, learning about the neighborhood history and a resident-informed revitalization project. The tour will take a bus and drop off attendees for a 1 mile walk through the neighborhood.

Grand Rapids River Restoration: This dynamic tour will show off the Grand River and its adjacent parks and recreational spaces, while learning about current efforts to restore the river's overall health and, most recently, its rapids as a catalyst for economic, environmental, and equity benefits. This is a 4 mile biking tour – bikes/helmets provided.
