VOTER EDUCATION AND OUTREACH

VOTER EDUCATION AMBASSADORS

- Program was created in 2012 in response to the passage of Wisconsin's voter ID law
- Volunteers trained to provide information related to voter ID, voter registration, accessibility, and the election process
- Over 500 ambassadors were trained in 2016 and 2017
- Outreach materials are provided by the Clerk's office



MOCK ELECTIONS

- Held at community events focusing on families and/or children
- Get to the parents through their children



VOTER REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION AT CITY AGENCIES

- Voter registration offered at all city agencies
- Identify situations to include information regarding voter registration
- Meet people where they are



EARLY VOTING

PRIOR TO NOV 2016

- Early voting restricted to ten days and only from 8 am to 7 pm
- Voting was allowed at only one location per municipality
- In high turnout elections, Madison would have over 1,000 early voters per day



NOVEMBER 2016 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION

- Early voting sites at 14 locations throughout the city
- Six weeks of early voting offered
- All public libraries offered early voting
- Three locations on college campuses

November 2012	18,572
November 2014	8,811
November 2016	57,260
